Directions:

- 1. Go to my web site and click on the Wikipedia Link
- 2. Pick any topic you would consider yourself an expert on and open the article about it by typing it in the search box.
- 3. Compile a list of information that you know for sure is <u>true</u> and you know is <u>false</u> on a scrap sheet of paper.
- 4. Find at least 10 pieces of information from this article.
- 5. You will then type your findings according to the requirements.

Requirements:

- Open a <u>blank canvas</u> and save it as <u>P8 8-6 last name first name</u>.
- □ Create a <u>Text Box</u> and place 8-6 Wikipedia in the center.
- Drag it up so it appears like a header.
- Place your name, date, and period on the right hand side of the text box.
- Create another text box and place the name of your topic in any color, font, and size you wish.
- Create a new text box and create two columns and head one <u>true</u> and <u>false</u> in the center of the column.

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- Make each column a <u>different font, size, and color</u> of your choice.
- Make sure each "fact" has some type of bullet in front of it and they are aligned to the left.
- Use google images to place at least one picture of your topic on your document.
- Any pictures you place on your document must have either a frame, reflection, or shadow.
- Your document must have a background.
